Chili Lunch Report - 10/15/15

As of 10/15/15, the Annual Soup Luncheon has raised \$2,502. In addition to member ticket sales, this total includes tickets purchased at the door \$160, Split-the-Pot \$115, and \$27 in cash donations.

This year, the Board raised the number of tickets members are required to sell from 5 to 7 (\$25 to \$35) in an effort to raise more funds to better support current projects and programs and possibly add new ones. The cost per ticket remains \$5 because it is a good price point.

359 tickets were taken (101 more than last year!): 328 from presales (121 more than last year), 31 from walk-ins (20 less than last year).

Thank you to the members with the highest ticket sales! Jim Hughes 42 tickets (\$210), Steve Chamley 28 (\$140), Martha Bruckner 21 (\$105). Thank you Jim, for also promoting the event and posting flyers in downtown Council Bluffs!

The only expense was \$350 for the Masonic Temple rental. Everything else was donated. Ameristar donated salad, salad dressing, butter, crackers. Rotella donated dinner rolls (Christine O'Connor). HGM (Ron Tekippe, Jared Olson) donated flyers, signs, tickets. Donna Pritchard donated to-go containers from Larsen Supply.
