Rotary Soup Luncheon October 20, 2016

As of the date of the luncheon the funds raised are \$2,219. A portion of the proceeds will go to Rotary International's Polio Plus Program. The remainder will go to other club projects and programs. Each member is required to purchase/sell 7 tickets at \$5/ticket (\$35). 37 members still owe for tickets which translates to \$1,295. After expenses and all members have paid for their tickets, net proceeds should be \$2,813. In addition to member ticket sales, the total raised includes tickets purchased at the door \$35 and Split-the-Pot \$189. 290 tickets were taken - 283 from presales, 7 from walk-ins.

The only expense was \$350 for the Masonic Temple rental. Everything else was donated. Holiday Inn/Main Event Catering (Barb Murphy) donated salad, salad dressing and toppings for 200. Olive Garden donated salad, salad dressing and breadsticks for 50. Rotella donated rolls. HGM (Ron Tekippe, Jared Olson) donated flyers, signs and tickets. IWCC (Dan Kinney) donated silverware, plates, bowls, cups, and napkins. Donna Pritchard donated soup crackers and to-go containers. Northcrest Living Center (Steve Chamley) donated coffee and tea. The Red Cross (Jill Orton) donated use of beverage coolers. Hoy-Kilnoski (Mike Hoy) and Maher-Livingston (Mike Maher) donated paper placemats with Rotary on them. Hy-Vee donated a \$50 gift card and Super Saver donated a \$20 gift card - cards were used to purchase salad, salad dressing and desserts. A big thank you to these generous donors!
