**November 12 Program**  
**Chuck Erickson - Zambian Project**

The Zambia project began in 2005 with small projects to support orphanages, a clinic and to educate villagers on health issues and clean water projects. Most recently the project received a 3-year, \$150,000 Rotary Foundation Global Grant to fund clean water, agricultural projects and nutritional education.

The project has several partners:

SAM Project

UNL Chapter of Engineers without Borders

UNL College of Public Health

Engler Agribusiness Entrepreneurship Program

Hydrogeologist Dan Blankenau

Other individuals and organizations - Rotarians and non-Rotarians

Our club has supported this project in some way since its inception. Deceased club member and Past District and Club President Doris Heineman was instrumental in getting this project started. Beginning in 2008, the club committed to contribute \$125/year for 5 years to the project and gave an additional contribution of \$500 in 2013. Club member Dr. Phil Meyer has made two trips to Zambia with the team and Past Club President Mick McKinley is the District Rotary Foundation Grants Chair for Global Grants.

To follow this tradition, the Club Board is considering making a contribution to this project this year. Project needs are:

\$6,000 Borehole (water)

\$2,000 Interns

\$1,000 Meal supplements

\$500 Borehole pump repair
