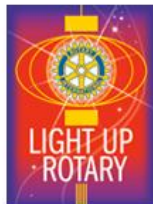

Larry Knotek & Lisa Yilmaz

Larry Knotek - Larry was born in Ravenna, Nebraska. His family moved to Iowa in 1945 where he grew up on an acreage near Dutch Hollow and College Road in Council Bluffs. He has five siblings. He went to grade school at St. Peter's and High School at Abraham Lincoln where he participated in wrestling and music. He attended ISU and received a degree in mechanical engineering. He married his high school sweetheart in 1957 and has been married 57 years! He graduated from ISU in 1958 with a commission in the Army. He was in the same unit of the Reserves as Stan Grote. His first job out of college was three years with HDR.

As a professional engineer, Larry has worked with architects to build mostly commercial buildings. He spent 53 years at Alvine and still goes to work almost every day. He has six children, 12 grandchildren and three great grandchildren. In 1972 he became an ordained Deacon of the Catholic Church. In 1986 Larry and his wife founded the MICA House.

When Larry "retired" from Alvine in 1996 he and his wife started taking RV trips south for the winter and over the next 6 years they spent their winters in Arizona, Florida, Texas and other places. One day, Larry saw a brochure for a world cruise and decided to go for it. He and his wife went on a 65 day, 22 country cruise around the world that started in San Francisco and ended in Rome.
