February Board Meeting Summary

January Membership Report:

Attendance: 58%; Current membership: 93

January Treasurer's Report:

**Rotary Chili Luncheon Report
February 16, 2017**

As of Feb. 16, the Rotary Soup Luncheon has raised \$2,777.

\$2,500 of the proceeds will go to the Rotary 5th Grade Career Fair that will be held in April 2017. The remainder will go to other club projects and programs.

Each member is required to purchase/sell 7 tickets at \$5/ticket (\$35). 31 members still owe for tickets which translates to \$1,085. Bills will be emailed after the Feb. 23 meeting.

In addition to member ticket sales, the total raised to date includes tickets purchased at the door \$55 (\$20 more than the Soup Lunch) and Split-the-Pot \$202 (\$13 more than the Soup Lunch).

310 tickets were taken: 299 from presales, 11 from walk-ins. 20 more tickets were taken than at the Soup Lunch (16 more presales, 4 more walk-ins).

Thank you to the members with the highest ticket sales! Martha Bruckner 28 (\$140) and Steve Chamley 28 (\$140).

The only expense was \$350 for the Masonic Temple rental. Everything else was donated. Harrah's donated salad, salad dressing, soup crackers, rolls and butter. IWCC (Dan Kinney) donated silverware, plates, bowls, cups and napkins. HGM (Ron Tekippe, Jared Olson) donated flyers, signs and tickets. Northcrest Living Center (Steve Chamley) donated coffee and tea. The Red Cross (Jill Orton) donated use of beverage coolers. Hoy-Kilnoski (Mike Hoy) and Maher-Livingston (Mike Maher) donated paper placemats. A big thank you to these generous donors!
