Rotary Soup Luncheon Report February 18, 2016

As of 2/18/16, the Rotary Chili Luncheon has raised \$2,755. Proceeds will go to the Rotary 5th Grade Career Fair on April 12 and to other club projects and programs. Each member is required to purchase/sell 7 tickets at \$5/ticket (\$35). 32 members still owe for their tickets which translates to \$1,120. Bills will be emailed after the 2/25/16 meeting.

In addition to member ticket sales, the total raised to date includes tickets purchased at the door (\$120) and Split-the-Pot (\$223).

302 tickets were taken (15 less than last year): 278 from presales (10 more than last year), 24 from walk-ins (25 less than last year).
