March Board Meeting Summary

Membership Report:

Attendance: 64%

Current membership: 102

Treasurer was not present for meeting. Treasurer's Report was tabled until the April Board Meeting.

Other Business:

- The Club will not receive the Presidential Citation this Rotary Year - The Club is unable to achieve the Youth Service requirements.
- The Board is considering co-sponsorship of an Interact Club (Rotary for High School Students) or partnership with an existing youth service club.
- The Club will contribute \$500 of the January poker tournament proceeds to the Zambia Project for the purchase of high energy protein supplements (HEPS) for high risk infants during the current drought.
- Cost of Social Event/Membership Drive on Mar. 31 was raised to \$15/person to allow for more beverage choices.
- In observance of Administrative Professionals week, Rotarians will be asked to invite a member of their support staff to lunch for the April 28 meeting.
- Board is considering District Grant ideas.

- The Club has received no youth exchange applications, the Club will not host an exchange student in 2016-17.

- Erin Johnson and Stacy Schultz will attend Rotary Leadership Institute on April 23.
