The population of Council Bluffs is 62,000 - 8.5% or 5,277 are Latino. The Council Bluffs Community School District has 9,000 students - 15% or 1,300 are Latino. IWCC's student population is 7% Latino. In Council Bluffs, 14.1% of the population is a minority race or ethnicity. The population of Iowa from 2000-2010 increased by 120,000 (4%) - 69,000 (59%) of those new Iowans were Latino - 84% of those new Iowan's were Latino.

El Centro Latino's purpose is to educate and empower to help Latinos be self sufficient, safe and healthy and able to provide more opportunities for their children.

El Centro's programming includes: family support (translation services, access to health care, employment assistance), civic engagement, adult education (English, citizenship, GED, computer classes), and legal aid.
