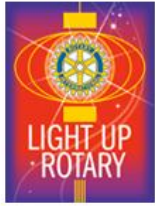

May Board Meeting Summary

Executive Director's Report:

Attendance: Mar 61%, April 57%

Current membership: 91

2014-15 Budget Goal: 105 - Recruitment must be a focus of the Club in order to meet club's financial commitments.

Treasurer's Report:

March - Income: \$2,298.35; Expenses: \$6,442.92; Deficit: \$4,144.57

Expenses: Career Fair \$2,500, RYLA \$400, The Center Donation \$100, Hilton Centennial Celebration Deposit \$500, Nonpareil Subscription \$150.

April- Income: \$5,271.26; Expenses: \$3,967.58; Excess \$1,303.68

Expenses: Centennial Celebration Band \$1,400

Income: Centennial Celebration Payments \$2,300

YTD Deficit: \$8,859.46

Other Business:

- 87 people attended Centennial Celebration. Hilton set and billed for 90 - \$2,460.25.
 - The Club will not apply for a 2015-16 District Grant. The 100 year Project does not meet requirements. Additionally, the club would need to hold another fundraiser in addition to the four already scheduled in order to raise matching funds.
 - The Club will not contribute to the Zambia Project this Rotary year. No funds are available in the budget. The project has raised the funds needed for their volunteer doctor to travel to Zambia.
 - ALHS students Audrey Hale and Harrison Jones attended the RYLA retreat in April.
 - The four voting delegates to the May 14 District Annual Meeting were Steve Chamley, Mick McKinley, Stacy Schultz and Jay Simms.
 - Steve Chamley and Rick Guill will attend the Quarterly Metro Presidents Breakfast on May 29.
 - The club's Changing of the Guard Steak Fry will be delayed until July so it won't conflict with the District Rotary Day on June 27. Date will be announced soon.
 - District Conference will be August 21-22 at the MAC.
 - Committee Chairs will be working with President Elect Rick Guill to build committees for 2015-16 Rotary Year.
