August Board Meeting Summary

July Membership Report:

Attendance: 38%

Current membership: 95 - Paul Crane, Ric Miller, Linda Robicheau resigned and Verne Welch passed away.

July Treasurer's Report:

Income: \$1,109.57; Expenses: \$6,338.19; Deficit: \$5,228.62; RI Dues of \$3,901.38 were paid in July. Payment includes dues at \$28/member plus insurance and magazine subscriptions. RI dues will increase by \$4/member over each of the next three years beginning July 2017.

Other:

- The Club is switching to Square credit card processing. The only fees associated are 2.75% per swipe. Costs will be half as much as those of the Club's current credit card processing company.
- The 2016-17 Budget was discussed. Additional consideration is needed. The Budget will be reviewed at the September meeting.

- The Board is considering sponsoring/hosting a youth exchange in 2017-18. Items up for consideration are a budget of \$1,500+, 2 club members to volunteer to be the exchange officer and counselor for a year and the availability of host families.
 - The Club will have a social event in October.
 - A policy committee headed by Tom Hanafan will be formed to determine where club policies are needed and to determine policies as issues arise.
 - Rotary Soup Lunch is October 20 at the Masonic Temple.
 - The Board reviewed the 2015 Council on Legislation Essential Changes for Clubs and Districts (see attached).
