Vocational Talks

Cati DeMasi & Rian McGill

Cati DeMasi - I grew up in upstate NY and lived there until I was 26. I moved to Nebraska for grad school never thinking I would stay in the Midwest but ended up being recruited by Ron Hopp (then Director) to work for Council Bluffs Parks and Recreation. I served as Recreation Coordinator and then Recreation Superintendent for nearly 10 years, working with a great crew! Among many memorable experiences, I was a participant in Leadership Class XII, served as Council Bluffs Community Pride Chair for a couple of years, coordinated the Korean American Cultural Foundation event for Korean War veterans and coordinated the Olympic Torch Relay celebration that was hosted in Council Bluffs in 2002.

In 2008, I decided to go back to school to earn my teaching certification. I studied at Idaho State University in Pocatello, ID and Winthrop University in Fort Mill, SC, but ultimately decided to move back to the Midwest in 2010 to pursue my Recreation Therapy certification instead. I completed my internship at Immanuel Rehabilitation Center, then coordinated recreation programming for QLI in their long-term care facility for people with brain and spinal cord injuries for about two years. I next helped open Immanuel Pathways Omaha as their first Recreational Therapist in 2012.

In 2014, I was recruited by a co-worker to come to Children's Square to help start their pediatric Integrated Health Service. I served as the Assistant Director of the program until May, 2015, when I was selected to be the new Executive Director for the Center. I also work part-time at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in their adult behavioral health unit, serve on the Council Bluffs Planning Commission, assist with planning for Youth Leadership Council Bluffs, and volunteer for the St. Vincent DePaul Society and Historic General Dodge House.

I love Council Bluffs and joined Rotary so I could continue to serve the community as much as possible.

Rian McGill - Rian joined American National Bank as a Financial Consultant in the Wealth Management Division in April 2014.
